1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.
2. The HCHK Creditors are authorized to intervene in the Adversary Proceeding with full participation rights.
3. The HCHK Creditors are authorized and empowered to take all actions necessary to implement the relief granted in this Order.
4. This Order shall be effective and enforceable immediately upon entry.
